ARISE AND TAKE OVER

- DR SIJU ILUYOMADE

At the 14th ARISE Women's Conference, Dr Siju Iluyomade, the Convener of ARISE Women's Conference charged women to be confident in themselves to ARISE and take over nation-building. The conference which was tagged, "By Appointment" was held in four locations along COD Road, Victoria Island, Lagos - The locations were, the Trinity Towers, City of David Sanctuary, Incubator, and Havilah Event Centre on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

In her welcome address, Dr Siju reiterated the need for women to be involved in nation-building. She stated that Nigeria is facing a huge decline simply because data and statistical overview show that Nigeria ranks lowly on Gender Equality and Inclusion. Out of 178 countries examined, Nigeria ranks at 139 and it's projected as a country that still maintains legal barriers that prevent women from full economic participation and access to funds. Nigeria has a long road to gender equality with unimaginable records of death, rape, child bride, poverty and political disenfranchisement that prevent women from mainstream governance. The United Nation SDGs says that sustainable communities cannot be built without women's inclusion. Deborah saw the great decay in Israel, and she was courageous to stand in the face of fear to make a difference. Judges 5:7 says, "Deborah arose as a mother in Israel."

Understanding appointment and securing the future, ARISE WOMEN AROSE AS MOTHERS IN NIGERIA 14 years ago to deliver a better quality of life to our communities through sustainable development. ARISE has today built schools. promoted preventive healthcare by being proactive, not reactive through its ARISE WALK FOR LIFE, a global success, introducing exercises, and sports as a tool for preventive healthcare delivery. 





BY APPOINTMENT

t was another beautiful time to be back in God's presence after the summer break at the Handmaidens Fellowship on Wednesday, September 7, 2022, as Pastor Siju Iluyomade preached on "BY **APPOINTMENT."** Find below excerpts.

Have you ever experienced a shift in your life – a new season - a time that something ends, or a time of new beginnings? Have you ever experienced a time when sorrow ends, and true happiness begins? Have you ever experienced the time deep sighs beginning to bring a ray of hope and sunshine? Have you ever wondered why certain things happen at a certain time? Have you ever heard the saying, "Keep on living until your change comes?" That is, "BY APPOINTMENT!"

Job did everything to safeguard the problems, yet he was afflicted. He sat like many people who are married and fought through the battles. Job stayed through his shame, trials and ridicule. Job withstood his pain like Teflon material. He refused to deny His Maker and trusted God who does things in seasons. Some have toiled all night yet caught nothing. But the God Almighty by appointment changes the season. Greater is the latter end from the beginning, but that is only when you activate it. You must recognise that the days of sorrow are over. You are teflon material, you mustn't wear your scars on your face. Like teflon material, you can withstand extreme pain and bounce it off.

There's a time for everything under heaven. Man has no authority over the seasons. You have done everything right to build a good marriage, home, health, business, and career, yet things fall apart. It is human nature to try to control our circumstances or work hard to prevent certain things from happening, but it doesn't go as planned. This is because it's all in God's appointed time (Ecclesiastes 3). Proverb 29:18 says, "Where there is no vision, the people perish..." The question is: When you started in marriage, did you articulate your vision? Did you dedicate your marriage to God? 1 Chronicles 12:32 says, "Of the children of Issachar, men who had an understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do..." Do you understand the times, and do you know what you ought to do in the season you're in? For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end, it shall speak. Through all the changing scenes of life, your appointment is to God. Be positioned in your family, home, career and business because you are appointed by God to be in authority and dominion. The alarm clock goes off for you to arise; you have an appointment for greatness.





God operates in eternity, and time doesn't matter to Him. God works not with time but with His plan and ordained purpose. Forget shame, it's time for your breakthrough. Let your work speak for you. Anywhere space you operate should be a place of blessing. Israel in exile was still a place of blessing. Any situation you are in is a place of responsibility, not to the person hurting you, but to God who has appointed you. No matter what you go through in life, it is by God's divine appointment. As we are appointed by His Divine Majesty, let us understand where we are, and what to do with our positioning. Does it strengthen us for greater work, or does it birth a newness of life? Begin to write your history.





BY APPOINTMENT

t was another awesome time in God's presence at the Handmaidens Fellowship on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, as Pastor Siju Iluyomade continued her teaching on "BY APPOINTMENT." Find below excerpts.

Did you know that the late Queen Elizabeth II was not born to be Queen, but she was appointed to the throne? God sought and chose her to reign. She needed to keep not only history but a legacy. Just as the LORD has appointed us at this time in the phase of our nation to keep a legacy. Interestingly, this is happening to us just as we are entering an election year. I wish women could understand the power they carry to appoint their leaders. The leaders don't appoint you; you appoint them. The late Queen Elizabeth II wore the garb of that office never losing her femininity. She had issues in her marriage, but she refused to allow them to define her. She settled it and moved on graciously. Her last appearance was a promise kept dedicating her whole life to the service of the Commonwealth. In like manner, we are promise keepers; we are appointed by God for a time as this to transform this nation. Women played a substantial role in ending Liberia's two civil wars. Their children were used as child soldiers, and they had to stop it. The women arranged meetings between Taylor and the rebel leaders in Accra, earning a reputation as peacemakers. The question is: What have you done about this nation? What is your clarion call? What is your passion? When you go to a village where there's no water, or when you see a woman who has a very intelligent child that cannot afford school fees or you see someone in need, are you concerned?

The Bible tells us that Jacob was in a place of distress. He ran from his brother whom he had swindled. He knew his father who had blessed him will soon die, and his beloved mother, he may not see again. Who was going to hold his brief? So he ran from Esau in shame knowing that his brother wanted to kill him. God interrupted Jacob's darkness, and he laid before the Almighty. He turned the place where he was going to languish and die into an altar of worship called "BETHEL" and his expectation changed forever (Genesis 28:19).

Where is Your Bethel?

You can as well turn your pains into an altar of worship. Are you going through a rough patch in your parenting, marriage, career, or business? Turn it into an altar of worship. Bethel the house of God. It is time to rename that pain and turn it into a place of worship or a place of divine appointment. Ask God to come into the challenges and do something new in your life.

At the height of Jacob's pain, and shame, God shone. Instead of Jacob shaming God, He decided to appoint him for greatness. Amid his pain, Jacob was assured of God's identity and purpose for him. God changed his name from Jacob to Israel. Jacob bore the 12 tribes that became Israel. The appointed time is the season of God. In God's appointed time, disappointments and frustrations will bow; you become upgraded.

Moses gave five reasons to run from the work of God. He suddenly forgot that he was raised a Prince and he thought he wasn't qualified. Moses told God he wasn't good enough to carry out God's assignment because the people will



not believe him. He said, "O my LORD, I am not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I am **slow of speech, and of a slow tongue** (Exodus 4:10). He gave excuses to run from God's divine appointment for him. God has appointed you, He has chosen you, and He is mindful of you. God does not want you to bring shame to His name, so, find your purpose. It is your year of appointment and change. God is only waiting for you to grow into it. Remember, your blessings will also come with responsibility. Do not run from your God-given appointment. Don't deny or resist your position, rather work in that grace that God has given you. You may fall, but surely you will rise again.

Do not miss the appointment of God because if you do, He gets offended. He appointed Samson and Saul, but they messed up. God appointed David because of the sin of Saul and combined both the priesthood and the kingship in one man. Habakkuk 2:3 says, "For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end, it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry." It is God who appoints. Genesis 18:14 says, "Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son."


